## Safety Flashes - a look back at recent trends

This is a summary of the seventeen IMCA Safety Flashes published so far during 2021. All the published safety events or incidents are available on the IMCA website as individual web pages at https://www.imca-int.com/safety-events. Safety Flashes, comprising a number of events or incidents collected as a PDF, are circulated to members by email.

How many? 17 published so far in 2021 comprising 82 events or incidents (including summary of 2020)	<u>Who contributes?</u> 55 of those events or incidents came from 22 IMCA members	Public domain events MSF, NTSB, MAIB, UK HSE and others
Equipment failure Equipment failure (including corrosion) was a factor in 13 events or incidents	<u>Injured people</u> 13 injuries in events or incidents published in the last six months	<u>Six hand or finger</u> <u>injuries</u> in events or incidents published in the last six months
<u>Dropped objects</u> An issue in nine events or incidents	<u>Stop the job!</u> In six incidents or events, someone was successfully able to "stop the job", or, failure to "stop the job" was a causal factor	<b>IOGP LSR</b> Bypassing safety controls 29% Line of Fire 27% Lifting 10%

The 17 Flashes comprised 82 individual incidents or events. 55 of those incidents or events came from 22 IMCA members. We welcome Safety Flash submissions from our members.
